

WATERLOO PARKS BOARD

SEPTEMBER 14,2016

PRESENT : John, Ed, Dwight, Ken, Jan, Jay, Bill, Tena and Aaron Pino

Ed, President called the meeting to order at 5:05 pm. Minutes were approved as read.

PANKOP PARK: Cement is poured and frame work is up with the help of Ken, John, and Dwight plus others from the town. Needs the sheeting and ridge cap. Nucor will help finish the pavilion. Tena will call 811 to mark utilities before holes for the trees and swing set poles are drilled. Chris Albright is waiting to hear from us. Still need to get ideas for set up of playground.

THOMSON PARK: Ed finally got a response about the playground covering. We are not covered for damages. So we will have to figure out how much we need for the bad spots, buy the material and pour ourselves per directions. It was decided to wait till spring to let the ground settle. We will also wait to fix the arbor. Camera at park was struck by lightning and is getting repaired.

SKATEPARK: Aaron Pino president of the skatepark committee shared an update on the progress of the park. Tentative size will be 101 X 130 on the 1/3 of an acre. Aaron asked on behalf of the committee for funding to do a soil test and survey. Would we be willing to pay half of the estimate \$2500.00 they recd'd from a&z engineering and GME testing. Ken made a motion and Jay 2<sup>nd</sup> to pay half of the expense \$1250.00. Motion passed depending on if the rest of the money is raised. Town will keep the soil testing results. Aaron will also be meeting with United Way and Auburn Economic Board soon.
