New Business:

1. Council voted to hire Woodland Designs to remodel 280 S Wayne St (New Town Hall). Council also approved a \$10,000.00 limit to do what is necessary to get the move done. Woodland Designs gets \$6,650.00, and Renata gets \$3,350.00.
2. Council voted for the ribbon cutting of the New Town Hall, and the Depot to be on June 24th 2016. Starting with Town Hall at 10am, and then moving to the Depot. Open House at both locations will be from 10am – 6pm on that same day.
3. Council voted to put 280 N Wayne St up for sale at a price of \$42,500.00, and will also be an open bidding process.
4. Council voted to hire Henderson Construction to do curbs on West Van Vleek St in the amount of \$41,494.00


Other Business:
