Public Hearing:


1. Ryan Swanson, Casey's representative, gave a recap of the alleys to be vacated. It had already gone before the plan commission and approved. Jess Jessup Motioned and Bill Hubartt 2nd. Ordinance 18-01
2. Ryan Swanson talked about the vehicle study he did for Union Street. He will be sharing the information with INDOT and wait for them to respond. Ryan did not see an issue with the timing of the lights and cars being backed up on Union Street.

Special Meeting Topics

1. First reading of ordinance to create a Deputy Town Manager/Code Enforcement position was passed. The board discussed taking out the probationary period, however, they decided to take it out of all employees' language at once later. Town Council reserves the right to approve the address of Deputy Town Manager. Wages will not come out of water or sewer. Deputy Town Manager will be able to make decisions when the Town Manager is unavailable.
2. Tena talked a little about the County Income Tax. She said other town's have not made a decision either.
