A meeting of the Waterloo Town Council was held May 15,2018 at 6:31 pm at the Waterloo Grant Twp. Library. Council members present were:

The following business was discussed and action taken: Unless specified all votes were unanimous.

Public Hearing:

1. Council approved rezone of W Maple Street adjacent to RP Wakefield, 600 W Maple Street from UR (Urban Residential) to LI (Light Industrial).
2. Public Hearing concluded at 6:46 p.m.

Committee/Council Reports:

1. Code Enforcement reported on twelve permits issued so far this year with an estimated value of \$11,081,750.00.

Communications from the Town Manager:

1. Tena reminded everyone town wide garage sale was going to be June 8, 9 and 10th and the Circus was coming June 12th.
2. Julie Buss was hired and working at Town Hall as Deputy Clerk.

New Business:

1. April Minutes and Claims were approved
2. R.P. Wakefield tax abatement request was approved
3. May was proclaimed Pink Out month, **Resolution 18-01**
4. Council approved the Engineering services for Community Crossings. Dave Wolfe gave a report of the breakdown. \$115,050.00 will come from MVH and \$146,000.00 will come from LOIT. Dave and Mark will do some curb painting.
5. Tena also has approval to apply for the Community Crossing Grant
6. David Wolfe explained to the council why the speed limit needed to be changed on CR 28 and **Ordinance 18-05** was approved.
7. **Resolution 18-02** Lemonade Day Proclamation was approved

8. Tena asked if she could get quotes and take the money from Rainy Day Fund to finish the remodel of the meeting room at Town Hall
9. Tena explained to the council that she would like to have another meeting to discuss the Local Trax matching grant and that was approved


