Dear Business Leader;

The Town of Waterloo Park Board is going to build a new park and will honor our veterans, but we need your help to make it happen. For over 20 years, residents and community leaders have talked about creating a new recreation space on Waterloo property next to our water tower. We are ready to get it done.

After collecting public input and reviewing drawings of past ideas for the park, we have developed a plan that we believe will be the pride and joy of Waterloo for generations to come. When completed, every resident in our town will live within a half mile of a park with easy access to free recreational opportunities.

It's a big project so we're going to build it in two phases. Enclosed you will find a drawing of the entire park plan. First, we will create a fishing pond and build a sledding hill. We'll pave a trail to those features and install a fence for a dog run. Benches, a drinking fountain and signage will complete phase 1, which can be constructed within the year. The rest of the park will be done in Phase 2.

Your donation to the Veterans Park can create the momentum we need to launch the fundraising. Between March 16-May 1, we will be "crowd funding" for support from the community. Thanks to a matching grant from the Indiana Housing & Community Development Authority Creating Spaces program, every gift (up to \$10,000) will be matched, if we meet the total goal of \$47,348. We hope you will make a donation and help us double the money!
