The meeting was called to order by Sallie Pease at 5:02 PM.

- A joint meeting needs to be scheduled with Main Street and the Redevelopment Commission to discuss the rehabilitation grant.
- The meeting for the Redevelopment Commission scheduled for September 27, 2023 is canceled due to the DeKalb County Free Fall Fair.
- Russ Goodman and Sallie Pease gave an update on the visit to the LaGrange Public Safety Building. Below are some of the things that were noted.
 - The LaGrange building is a retrofit. It was previously a car dealership.
 - Eighty percent of the building currently meets their needs.
 - Decontamination was an issue in that building.
 - More rooms needed
 - Secured areas are essential for the police department
- A time needs to be scheduled to visit the Ligonier Fire Department.
- Pease stated that spending goals need to be sent to the state by December 1, 2023.
