- 1. Work session:** Caudill opened the meeting to discuss opioid money. Goodman believes the money is better to stay in Waterloo than going to the county. He described uses that would benefit Waterloo. Such as vending machines, equipping the fire department and directly giving to county programs.

Discussion of the pros and cons of having a Narcan station was held.

Garman and Goodman are concerned that Waterloo will be put on the wayside if it is a county wide program. Caudill believes training should fall back on the municipality and the money should go to those in need of help.

Motion to keep the opioid funds in town made by Iddings (Garman) passed.
