

Waterloo Town Council Meeting  
April 23, 2025

A meeting of the Waterloo Town Council was held April 23, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. at the Waterloo Town Hall. Members present were:

The following business was discussed, and action was taken: Unless specified all votes were unanimous.

1. **Police Vehicles Equipment:** Jay Oberholtzer explained that he would like to get 2 new Kenwood car radios. The total is \$6,700.00. He will use the remaining money already appropriated in the general fund and the rest will be paid out of the Marshal fund. He also would like to purchase a radar for \$2,500.00. That would also be paid out of the Marshal fund. Duszynski reviewed the Marshal fund and explained there will be an additional appropriation needed but there is enough money in the fund for the purchase. Motion to approve made by Garman (Goodman) passed.
2. **Town Camera's:** Oberholtzer also presented a quote from Williams Electronics and Lakeland to repair the cameras. Williams Electronics' quote was \$4,853.00 and Lakeland is \$2,600.00. He feels Lakeland will be more efficient as well. Garman questioned the amount of cable required on the Williams Electronics quote. He felt it was overstated. Oberholtzer will contact them.
3. **Garbage Ordinance:** Duszynski stated that this is the second reading. She reviewed the change was adding the 2026 rates. Motion to wave rules and pass on 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> reading Garman (Iddings) passed. Motion to approve made by Goodman (Surber) passed.
4. **INDOT:** Howard brought the INDOT proposed SR 427 speed zone to the council last month, and the council asked Howard to work with INDOT and Oberholtzer to find an appropriate speed. INDOT reviewed the proposed changes and agreed with the town's findings. The council reviewed the revised proposal. Motion to approve made by Garman (Goodman) passed.
5. **CD Interest:** Pull Interest and roll over.


