A meeting of the Waterloo Town Council was held on March 19, 2026, at 5:55 p.m. at the Waterloo Historic Train Depot present were:

The following business was discussed, and action was taken: Unless specified, all votes were unanimous.


Fire Department Truck for Chief: Goodman explained that the truck was already sold. Caudill asked how Marshal's got it reserved. Duszynski explained that the dealer that they get the police cars from holds them with a purchase order, but they are dealing only with municipalities. Chief Hobbs looks at dealerships where anyone can buy a vehicle from, so they are less willing to just hold the vehicle. Duszynski explained the possibility of sending earnest money. Iddings asked the purpose. Caudill explained that the chief cannot respond directly to an incident with lights and sirens outside of town limits in a personal vehicle. This will also reduce response time since the vehicle will have equipment on it. Surber clarified it will be a take-home vehicle; Caudill confirmed. Surber was not comfortable with offering the fire department a take-home vehicle since other departments are not allowed. Motion to approve the authorization of the liaison to approve up to \$40,000 for the purchase of a truck for the fire chief, since it has been approved in the budget made by Wright (Iddings) passed with a vote of four to one, with Suber opposed.
